

TERMS OF USE for the Asbestos Art Space

All users of the space commit to the terms of use of the Asbestos Art Space.

You can organize many different types of events in the Asbestos Art Space.

Apply for a time for your event by downloading the application form, filling it and sending it to us to our e-mail address asbsts@gmail.com

You also need to read the terms of use for the space.

Our exhibition slots are quite short but negotiable. This, because we seek to leave room for spontaneous use of the space every month. We do not charge rent of the usage of our space.

You can use the space in two different ways:

1. With the Asbestos collectives help, so that the collective helps you with the organizing of the event.
2. Independently where by one asbestos member works with you as a contact person, handing out the keys and instructs you as the space user.

Terms of use for the space:

- There has to be silence between 22-07 in the space.
- If you lose the key to the space you have to pay for changing the locks of the space and for new keys.
- You have to be 18 years old as an organizer
- Clean up after yourselves
- Be familiar with the safer space rules and follow them
- Add the accessible info and safer space info in a possible Facebook or other event
- You cannot advertise alcohol in possible event. You can serve alcohol at an exhibition opening for example but you cannot advertise it at all. The only exception is if you get a sponsor. Then you can mention in the Facebook event for example that the X corporation is sponsoring beverages at the event.
- You cannot sell beverages or food at your event
- When you make an event put Asbestos Art Space as co-organizer so it automatically gets updated on our page.
- The user of the space defines the day-to-day opening hours of the event. The opening hours have to appear in the Facebook event for example and are binding. We will put the opening hours on our website so you can't change them later.
- The Asbestos collective has the right to organize activities and events in the space during a guests usage of the space. The collective will inform about possible the same time usage of the space in this case and discuss the ways to make it happen best for all parts involved.
- The user of the space has to overlook and monitor their event or exhibition on their own. The Asbestos collective does not help you with this.
- The Space needs to look exactly the same when you start your usage of the space and when you give back the keys.
- If you for example need to paint the walls because you made holes in the wall contact your contact person of the Asbestos collective immediately. You will have to pay a small fee for using our paint.
- The space has to be clean when you give the keys back to the collective.
- The space needs to be clean and well mantled during opening hours. Also the pavement outside the space needs to stay clean. No ash trades or trash etc. can be left there overnight.
- The Asbestos collective has a right to demand demonstrative pictures of your works for your upcoming event. Or a trailer of some sort.
- The user of the Asbestos Art Space has to commit to the fact that the works they show have to be in line with the Asbestos collectives manifest. So if the Asbestos collective feel like the works do not correlate with the collectives values, the Asbestos collective can demand the user to take them down. Not to exhibit them.
- Because we rent out the space for free, we do not support events that have a fee in our space.

Our principles

Asbestos Art Space is a space where the safer space principles are used. If a member of the Asbestos collective is not present in an event you host you have to point out a responsible person for the safer space principles amongst yourselves. That person should know the safer space principles and be on a lookout the entire event for violations of them. Talk amongst yourself about how you can handle different situations and ask the Asbestos collective for help if you feel like you need more info about how to interfere in situations where the safer space principles are violated. You

can also learn about these strategies by different links the collective can provide for you if they seem to be unable to make it to your event. If a member of the asbestos collective is present at your event you can always turn to them for questions and support in dealing with safer space issues.

Asbestos Art Space operates according to Safer Space principles. Accessibility information; The width of the entrance is 71 cm. There is a 10 cm stair approximately 1m in front of the main entrance and a 10 cm high threshold. The toilet is not accessible.

SAFER SPACE PRINCIPLES:

A safe space is a place where anyone can feel as safe as possible. It is also essential that anyone steps in if questionable or harassing behavior is noticed. You can always turn to a member of Asbestos for help if you don't feel comfortable intervening by yourself.

Safer Space principles:

1. We don't tolerate sexism, racism, homophobia or discrimination against minorities (such as transphobia, islamophobia etc.) in our space.
2. Keep an open mind. Everyone has different experiences, thoughts and circumstances. Nobody can define anyone else's identity.
3. Respect is the key. Don't question anyone's uniqueness.
4. Give people their personal space. Do not harass anyone verbally, physically or by staring.
